

## Positive and Needs Work

ClassDojo reinforces our Positive Behaviour for Learning program. Students will receive positive points for displaying STARS behaviour.

If students are not demonstrating STARS behaviour they will receive a verbal warning and if the behaviour continues a 'needs work'. The needs work will not take any of the points away that they have earned.



## Connecting at Home

When a student receives a positive point or a needs work a notification is sent to the family member connected to the account. You can turn notifications off if you choose.

Seeing how your child is doing in class is great time to discuss and reflect on how their day went. If your child has a 'needs work' it is an opportunity to discuss what they could do to improve their behaviour next time.



## School Stories and Class Stories

School Story and Class Story read like a news feed that you may have on social media apps.

School Stories gives information to families to keep you up to date with important information. These may be posted by your child's teacher or another member of staff.

Class Stories are posts directly relating to your child's class and are usually posted by the class teacher or a teacher that has taught the class. These are often posts about lessons that your child has been learning in class.

## What is PBL?

Positive Behaviour for Learning is a program which teaches our students clear guidelines about the expectations we have for their behaviour. Students are taught to be “Stars Leading the Way” by demonstrating the following STARS qualities:

- **S**how Pride
- **T**ake Responsibility
- **A**ctive Learner
- **R**espect
- **S**afe



## PBL Rewards

As students demonstrate STARS behaviour they will receive ClassDojo points.

75 points—Bronze Award

125 points—Silver Award

200 points—Gold Award

Students will receive certificates for Bronze, Silver and Gold Awards. Students who receive Gold by the end of Semester will be able to participate in a Gold Reward. The Gold Reward is organised by the teachers in the PBL team using suggestions from the students.

## Teacher Consistency Across the School

We use the same PBL language across the school. Our STARS are a part of each classes’ rules and their Mission Statements. The STARS are displayed in each classroom and in the playground. Visiting teachers to our school are also made aware of the Warwick Farm STARS and behavior expectations.

When students are aware of what is expected of them they will feel more secure and able to learn.

Students learn that we expect them to be STARS Leading The Way in the classroom, in the playground and on excursions.

If students are not demonstrating STARS behaviour the teacher will follow the Warwick Farm Behaviour Management Plan which is displayed in all classrooms. The staff of Warwick Farm Public School have worked together to create this plan which supports students to learn to make better behaviour decisions.



## What is ClassDojo?

ClassDojo is an online program we are using to give immediate feedback and students parents and teachers can all be connected. Parents can see how their child is doing in real time. Only people with the access code can connect to our school.

You can download the ClassDojo app to your smart phone or connect using a computer.

Your child’s teacher will give you an access code to connect to their class.



## ClassDojo and Teacher Consistency

All teachers that work with a class are connected to the class’s ClassDojo. The points awarded are aligned with our PBL STARS. This reinforces the consistent teacher expectations across the school.
